WINTER 2007-2008 SNOWMOBILE ADVENTURES

One-Day Adventure Includes:

- Round trip transportation from your hotel (Jackson, Teton Village area) to Flagg Ranch Resort at the south entrance of Yellowstone where we begin our snowmobile tour.
- All snowmobile clothing, including suit, boots, gloves and helmet.
- Continental breakfast.
- Hot lunch, choice of menu at Old Faithful Geyser Grill.
- An experienced professional guide and of course a late model Polaris or an Artic Cat 4 stroke snowmobile for you to ride.
- All gas and oil.

 - One dinner on two-day tour, two dinners on three-day tour

Park Entry Fees:

If you possess a National Park "Passport" entry to the Park, please confirm the validity, otherwise there is a Park Entry Fee of \$15 per snowmobile for a single day and \$20 per snowmobile for multiple day tours. Entry fee's are NOT included in our price and must be paid separately.

Requirements: All drivers must possess a valid drivers license.

Deposit Policy: **Payment in full is due at the time of reservation.**

Cancellation Policy:

Refunds given only if cancelled 48 hours prior to arrival EXCEPT for Holiday periods in which case a 2 week notice is required. Refunds for cancellations during holiday periods will not be given unless we have rented all machines. All cancellations are subject to a \$25 cancellation fee per sled.

Thousands of visitors come to Wyoming to witness the sheer beauty and winter calm of world-famous Yellowstone National Park. The geysers and other fascinating formations are made even more unusual with the ever-present blanket of white snow and crisp winter air. We offer three very popular tour packages - two on snowmobiles and one via enclosed snow-van for those that opt for the comfort of a heated van. Please note: all snowmobile tours in Yellowstone are confined to the groomed roads of the Park.

We can also customize multi-day trips that include a visit to Yellowstone National Park. Contact our travel specialists for arrangements, suggestions and prices for most any size party. Below are Yellowstone tour details;

Old Faithful Tour via Snowmobile

Rise and shine! This is one of our earliest departures, with pickup around 6:30am and return to your hotel around 5:30 or 6:00 pm. We first travel north about 60 miles along the Grand Teton range to get to the Yellowstone area. Here you'll get a chance to meet others on your trip and take in the amazing countryside.

After orientation and check out on the machines, we'll travel nearly 100 miles on groomed trails from the south entrance of Yellowstone. We stop for lunch at the Geyser Grill at the Old Faithful Geyser Basin.

This tour has lots of stops along the way for pictures, discovering waterfalls, scenery, wildlife and of course Old Faithful - the world's most famous natural geyser. If time and conditions allow, you'll travel a few miles north to Biscuit Basin before heading back. **Snowmobile drivers must have a valid drivers license for this tour**, since travel is on the roads and highways of Yellowstone National Park.

There is an additional \$15 National Park Entrance Fee charged per machine. You may purchase an annual National Parks Pass from Rocky Mountain Snowmobiles on the day of your tour, or through the National Park Service online at buy.nationalpark.org.

Please note: A valid Driver's License is required in the operator's possession to drive a snowmobile in Yellowstone on any tour.

Visit the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone

Again, a long adventurous day with early pick up at the hotel around 6:00am and return about 7:00pm. If you've already experienced Old Faithful in winter, this is a great way to truly appreciate Yellowstone National Park.

Once we get to the park, we'll travel past Yellowstone Lake and Fishing Bridge through Hayden Valley on our way to the *Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone* which spans 20 miles in length and ranges from 800 to 1200 feet deep. This is some of the most beautiful country anytime of year, and in winter it seems especially photogenic. Elk and Bison are common in this area.

We'll travel about 125 miles on the groomed roads in the park.

SAMPLE Itinerary for 4 day multi-day trip

Day Prior to trip leaving: Arrive at Jackson Airport. (Please let us know airlines and arrival time). You will be picked up at the airport and brought into Jackson to your lodging. You will be staying at the Quality 49'er Hotel and Suites (307-733-7550), your hotel offers a hot tub and is located close to the Town Square, within walking distance of shops, restaurants and the night life of Jackson Hole. We will provide you with saddle bags the night before so that you may pack for your tour. The motel will store your luggage for your return. Enjoy your evening in Jackson Hole.

Day 1: Your guide will pick you up from your lodge around 6:30am. Have your luggage packed for storage and your bags ready to take along with you. Once you arrive at the snowmobile shop, your guide will outfit you in a snowmobile suit, helmet, and boots. After you are fitted in your suit, you will enjoy a continental breakfast. Your guide will travel to the south entrance of Yellowstone where you will begin your snowmobiling adventure. The first day you will travel past West Thumb Geyser Basin and along Yellowstone Lake. Throughout this entire trip you will encounter wildlife sightings so we do encourage you to bring your camera. The first night lodging accommodations is at the Buffalo Bill's historic hunting lodge in Pahaska Tepee, located at the east entrance of Yellowstone National Park.

Day 2: Today is going to be a little bit lengthier for you. You are going to make your way up through the spectacular frozen waterfalls of the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone observing on the way big game sightings and glorious high country scenery, making your way towards the North Entrance of Yellowstone. Before arriving in Gardiner you will have ample time to enjoy the Park Service interpretive displays and thermal areas at the Mammoth Hot Springs. You will be staying at the Best Western Lodge in Gardiner, Montana (5-miles outside of Yellowstone Park); this lodging does have pool, hot tub, and sauna for your pleasure. After a long day this may feel pretty good to you!

Day 3: After reentering the Park we head south past the steaming geysers of Norris Basin and the Gibbon River to our night's lodging at the Stagecoach Inn in West Yellowstone, Montana. The stagecoach is a historic hotel located at the center of all activities in West Yellowstone. The tastefully appointed rooms and superb restaurant make for a wonder place to sit back and relax. While you are at West Yellowstone you must check the Grizzly Discovery Center. Because the bears are fed all winter they do not hibernate so you can enjoy watching them. In addition to the Grizzly Bears the Center also contains numerous wolves that are active and visible to the visitor.

Day 4: After a relaxing night sitting in the hot tub, you will head towards the South entrance of Yellowstone. Along the way you will see many spectacular sights of the Park such as the Firehole Canyon, Biscuit Basin, and the famous Old Faithful Geyser. Along the way you will also be able to view Kepler Cascades, Shoshone Overlook, and Lewis Falls or other scenic areas of interest. Keep your camera handy!

Your guide will return you to the snowmobile shop where you will be notified of what time you will be picked up from your lodging and returned to the airport.
